## **Needle-free Connector Replacement** using Standard ANTT





A red number denotes where Key-parts or Key-sites need protecting.

Replace needle free connector/ extension at least every 7 days



Disinfect hands with alcohol hand rub or soap & water



Disinfect tray creating a General Aseptic Field



Prepare equipment using a disinfectant wipe§ -protecting Key-Parts with non-touch technique (NTT) & Micro Critical Aseptic **Fields** 



Disinfect hands with alcohol hand rub or soap & water\*

Prepare patient.

Ensure needlefree connector of device is accessible





Apply non-sterile gloves & disposable apron if

required



closed (if applicable), remove needle-free connector. keeping hold of device to

protect Key-Part (hub).



Scrub the hub of the device

## 'Scrub The Hub'

- Use a 2% chlorhexidine/ 70% alcohol wipe§
- Open the wipe fully & use NTT
- Scrub the hub tip for 15 seconds, creating friction using different areas of the wipe
- Allow to dry completely (for at least 15 seconds) before use.



Attach new needle-free connector

Unclamp (if applicable), and flush using 10ml 0.9% sodium chloride using NTT & a pulsatile technique and end on positive pressure. Re-clamp (if applicable) & remove syringe.



Patient zone

Apply new passive disinfection cap using NTT



Dispose of equipment

Remove gloves followed by apron (if either worn) & then immediately ...
